Operation Encompass

We have been asked to inform you about a new project that is being run across Rotherham. It is called Operation Encompass.

Operation Encompass has been designed to provide early reporting on any domestic violence incidents that occur outside of school and might have an impact on a child in school. It is an initiative which will enhance communication between the police and schools, where a child is at risk from domestic abuse.

School will be informed, when police attend an incident of domestic violence/ abuse, the following morning.

The designated member of the school staff (Miss Middleton) will use the information that has been shared, in confidence, whilst ensuring that the school is able to make provision for the possible difficulties experienced by children, or their families who have been involved in or witnessed a domestic violence incident

We are keen to offer the best support for our pupils and we believe this is going to be extremely beneficial for all those involved.
