

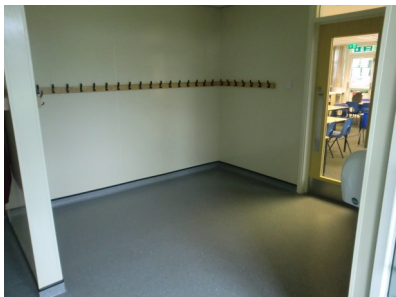


## Year 6
