

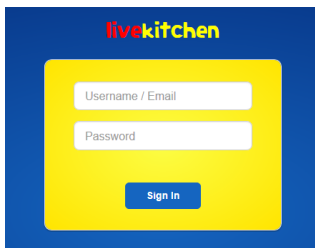


Dolce
